

CHD Partners has designed Cash in Transportation Training to assist employees who transport money or valuables. This training is required for security operatives every twelve months in New South Wales and Victoria as a requirement of the Cash in Transit Code of Practice (COP). Organisations that provide their own cash transportation function between one site to the other or between a site and the bank should also follow the requirements of the COP.

The training assists staff to understand their responsibilities under the COP and how to respond in a safe way in the case of an armed robbery. CHD Partners has conducted this training in New South Wales and Victoria.

Cash in Transportation Training is designed for up to 20 participants in each four-hour session. Sessions are individually tailored to suit specific local and site needs and can be extended as required.

### **The key learning outcomes for the sessions include:**

- Identify the principles that need to be implemented in surviving an armed confrontation
- Identify the effects of being involved in an armed robbery and the correct procedures to minimise the impact to personnel
- Identify the compliance requirements of the Cash in Transit Code of Practice
- Identify strategies to prevent armed robberies
- Identify the role of site risk assessments
- Identify safe practices for carrying cash in the workplace

### **The training incorporates the following adult learning principles and teaching techniques:**

- Brainstorming
- Small group exercises
- Role plays
- PowerPoint presentations

### **In preparing and delivering these sessions we will:**

- Provide each participant with a workbook and certificate of attendance
- Review site standard operating procedures to be included in training
- Customise training program to address local needs
